CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

The president of the **African Association of Agricultural Economists (AAAE)**, jointly with the president of the **Agricultural Economics Association of South Africa (AEASA)**, invites submissions for the **7th African Conference of African Agricultural Economists and the 60th AEASA Conference 2023** to be held from **September 18-21, 2023 in Durban, South Africa.**

These submissions may include full Contributed Papers and Organized Symposia. The theme of the conference will be; **THROUGH CRISIS: BUILDING RESILIENT AND SUSTAINABLE AGRI-FOOD SYSTEMS IN AFRICA.**

The deadline for all submissions is **March 7, 2023**. Corresponding authors will be informed of the outcome of the review and selection process by **June 6, 2023**. The final call for paper schedule can be downloaded from the [Conference](#) website

INFORMATION TO AUTHORS – PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

All lead authors who submit a contributed paper (whether oral/visual) must commit to the following:

1. That your paper(s) will not be accepted until you have registered and/or renewed your membership to the association and paid the conference fee
2. That you will serve on the **Reviewing Panel** for Contributed Papers, and the papers of authors who do not participate in the reviewing process for any good reason will be pulled from the program regardless of whether you have registered.
3. Each presenter may be a co-author of several Contributed Paper submissions but may only make ONE Oral and/or Visual Presentation.
4. Competitive travel grants covering part of the cost of attending the conference **may be** available to needy cases from low-income countries.

CONTRIBUTED PAPERS

Preparation of the text

1. The manuscript (English or French) should be submitted electronically to the Programs Committee at conference@aaae-africa.org
2. The manuscript should include an abstract at the beginning of not more than 250 words.
3. The text should be presented in Times New Roman, 12 pt., 1.15 Line spacing in Microsoft Word with 2.54 cm margins on A4 paper size.
4. The title page should include the title, the name(s) of the author(s) and their affiliation(s).
5. Articles should not be longer than 7500 words.

References

1. The Harvard method of referencing should be used in the form name(s) of the author(s), year of publication, page(s) referred to in the text, e.g. (Author, 1994:100).
2. The references should be in alphabetical and then chronological order in the References at the end of the contribution.
3. Footnotes and endnotes should be kept to a minimum. Endnotes are located ahead of the references.

Tables

A title, numbered consecutively, should be provided for each table, in bold above the Table, and all tables should be referred to in the text.

Figures

1. Figures should be numbered consecutively and referred to in the text. Only black-and-white Figures are accepted.
2. Figure captions should be in bold below the Figure.
3. Drawings should be completely lettered, the size of the lettering being appropriate to that of the drawings, taking into account the possible need for reduction in size (preferably not more than 50 per cent - width of lines should also be taken into account in this regard). The page format of Agrekon should be considered in designing the drawings.

ORGANISED SYMPOSIA

The **Organized Symposia** provide more flexibility than is available with Contributed Papers. We envisage that most of these proposals will include

presentations that explore different, complementary aspects of a particular topic. Proposals that involve discussants with different points of view will be of particular interest.

Each Symposium organiser should prepare and send a PDF file summarising the content of the proposal, including session title, session rationale, names and contact information for the organiser(s) and key participants, and a description of the symposium format that includes the question to be examined; the approaches used to analyse this question; the format to be used; and plans for discussion. The deadline for the Organized Symposia submissions is **March 7, 2023**
